Description and dimensions: Three-sided cenotaph with bronze plaques bearing the names. On the front, beneath a garlanded wreath, a bronze bas-relief of a standing, hooded, angel holding a palm frond. The memorial stands on a stepped platform surrounded by metal railings.

Height: appx. 457cms. Width appx. 400cms.
