Description and dimensions: Life-size stone statue of a kneeling uniformed soldier with rifle, on a square pedestal on a stepped platform. Inscription on bronze plaque at front, and on a board beside it. At the sides, stone bas-relief of scenes from Irish history. Height (including statue) appx. 350cms. Base appx. 120cms. square.
