SACRED TO THE MEMORY OF  
CAPTn THE HONBLE JOHN HELY HUTCHINSON  
OF THE 13<sup>TH</sup> REGT. OF DRAGOONS, AND OF BELMONT IN THIS PARISH,  
WHO DIED ON THE 2<sup>ND</sup> JULY 1855 IN THE 25<sup>TH</sup> YEAR OF HIS AGE AT SCUTARI  
WHERE HIS MORTAL REMAINS LIE UNDER A MONUMENT  
ERECTED BY THE AFFECTION OF HIS BROTHER OFFICERS.  
HE WAS CALLED AWAY FROM THE LOVE OF ALL WHO KNEW HIM  
TO DIE FOR HIS COUNTRY  
BY FOES MORE FORMIDABLE THAN ALL THE MIGHT OF RUSSIA  
DYSENTERY AND FEVER.  
THIS TABLET WAS ERECTED  
BY THE AGENT AND TENANTRY OF THE ESTATES IN THIS COUNTRY  
TO EXPRESS THEIR SORROW FOR HIS LOSS,  
BUT NOT AS THOSE WHO HAVE NO HOPE  
TRUSTING IN THE PROMISE,  
“HE THAT LIVETH AND BELIEVETH IN ME SHALL NEVER DIE”
