This tablet is erected  
to the memory of  
Major Charles Johnson Nicholson,  
of the Bengal Staff Corps,  
and brother of Brigadier General Nicholson.  
At Doomree  
on his way to join his station he died  
on the 18th. December, 1832,  
from the effects of a wound received at Delhi,  
Also to the memory  
of his wife, Lizzie Nicholson,  
who died of decline, at Cheltenham  
on the 17th May, 1833,  
surviving her husband only five months.  
" They were lovely and pleasant in their lives,  
And in their death they were not divided."
