Castleisland Volunteers 1916
The Castleisland company of the Irish Volunteers
was formed at this location on the 5th April 1914
after a hugh [sic] crowd was addressed from
the balcony of the Crown Hotel.
This plaque is dedicated to the memory of
the 100 volunteers from Castleisland, Cordal,
Currow, Scartaglin, Currans and Firies
who assembled at Dysart
on Easter Monday 24th April 1916
