\* This is the head of the statue of Admiral Horatio Nelson, which stood on top of 'Nelson's Pillar, in the middle of O'Connell Street, Dublin. The pillar was heavily damaged by a bomb set by the I.R.A on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 1966. The stump of the Pillar was subsequently removed.
