Position: In centre of road.

Description and dimensions: Celtic cross on oblong base which bears the inscription. The head of the cross has the badges of the Defence Forces, the Naval Service, the Air Corps and O.N.E.*

On the shaft of the cross are reliefs of Patrick Sarsfield and the Treaty Stone.
Height appx. 250cms, width of base appx. 100cms, depth appx. 50cms.
