Sacred to the Memory of
ABRAHAM AUGUSTUS NINN Esq.
Late Major in his Majesty's 1st West India Regt.
Who whilst gallantly Opposing with a handfull of brave Men
An innumerable Land and Naval French Force
Which most unexpectedly attacked
The Town of Roseau in the Island of Dominica
On the 22nd of Feb'y 1805
Received a Musket Ball in the Breast
which on the 14th of March following
Proved fatal and terminated His Career
Most universally lamented

As His Life was honourable and correct
So was His Death Glorious
For to the steady and gallant Conduct
Of Him and his Followers
In faithfully obeying the Orders they had received
Not to yield to the Enemy one Inch of Ground
Is the Country Indebted
Under Providence
To the preservation of that Island
His private Chatacter Comprehended every Virtue
The same Heart which unappalled
Stood foremost in the ranks of Danger and of Death
Was equally alive to the Duties of a Son,
To the Affections of a Brother
and the the Feelings of a Friend.
